

Anthony has been involved in Athletics since 1997 when he started competing as a 7yr old for Pakuranga. He continued through to the senior grades picking up numerous Auckland titles over a range of events and two bronze medals at National level.

After finishing competing he decided to move into officiating. He is one of 10 officials that were appointed to the International Technical Officials Panel for Oceania Athletics in 2015, the second highest level of officials' qualification in the world. He is also an International level 1 Lecturer and assists new and the younger officials in Auckland.

He held the role of Sport Development officer at Athletics Auckland for four years, where membership increased and clubs capability improved. He has also worked for Oceania Athletics as the Competition Manager before returning to Auckland where he works at Mt Albert Grammar School managing Athletics, Distance Running, Football Rugby and Triathlon.

He was also the chairman of the Junior Cross Country and Road section, Secretary of Senior Track and Field and was on the Pakuranga Management Executive. He was awarded a Service Award in 2015. He has also been Chairman of the Howick Athletics Club and involved as the Secretary of Counties Manukau Junior Athletics and previously as a Selector for the Interprovincial teams.

He has been appointed for the 2018 Commonwealth Games as the Assistant Track Referee and the Assistant Video Referee.
