### **NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**

### NOTE 1 STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

ATHLETICS AUCKLAND (INC) is an Incorporated Society established under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908 and is a reporting entity for the purposes of the Financial Reporting Act 1993 and accordingly these financial statements have been prepared in accordance with that Act. Athletics Auckland Inc also has Donee status for charitable grants approved by the Inland Revenue Dept.

### Differential Reporting

The organisation qualifies for differential reporting exemptions on the following basis:

- It does not have public accountability;
- It is within the required size criteria.

The organisation has taken advantage of all the differential reporting exemptions.

### Measurement Base

The accounting principles recognised as appropriate for the measurement and reporting of earnings and financial position on an historical cost basis have been used in the preparation of these financial statements.

### Specific Accounting Policies

- 1. Fixed assets are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation.
- 2. Depreciation has been calculated at rates as set out in the enclosed Fixed Assets/Depreciation Schedule.
- 3. All financial statements enclosed have been prepared on a GST exclusive basis unless otherwise stated.
- 4. Debtors have been stated at their estimated net realisable value.
- 5. The organisation is not liable for Income Taxation and accounts for GST under the payments basis.

### Changes in Accounting Policies

There have been no material changes in accounting policies during the year, however The Board acting on advice are maintaining a reserve of \$200,000 to preserve the going concern of AAI for a minimum of one financial year.
