



Auckland Secondary Schools Challenge Cup & Champions Cup

2020

In 2020 the Athletics Auckland Secondary Schools Track & Field Competition has changed to a twin points system resulting in two awards: the existing **Secondary Schools Challenge Cup** for overall points and the **Secondary Schools Champions Cup** for overall points divided by the number of events competed in.

The Challenge Cup and Champions Cup will be contested at the following meets:
31st October, 14th November, 21st November and 5th December.

Rules

School athletes must compete in school uniform.

Full Participation & Genuine Effort: Athletes are to make a genuine effort in all track and field events. To score points, a minimum of 3 trials is required in throws and horizontal jumps (except for retirement through injury, or clash of events, which will be at the discretion of the Chief Judge/Referee.)

Scoring

For both the Secondary Schools Challenge Cup & the Secondary Schools Champions Cup points are awarded to athletes based on event placings as follows:

Place	1st	2nd	3rd	4th	5th	6th	7th	8th	9th+
Points	10	8	7	6	5	4	3	2	1

Ranking

Secondary Schools Challenge Cup:

Points scored by all athletes from a school are totalled. Schools are then allocated points based on their order as per the table below.

Secondary Schools Champions Cup:

The total points scored by all athletes from a school is divided by the number of events competed in by athletes from that school. Schools are then allocated points based on their order as per the following table:
