Board discussed AAI fee options.

Concern was voiced that Office expenses (namely wages) needs to be taken into account with Registration fees the main source of income, aside from Grant funding which cannot be guarantteed in any given year. Current AAI fees compared with other Centres shows AAI middle of the table. Noted that additional event fees cover sectional expenses in putting on events.

DC worried that Winter Seasonal membership may eliminate some championship events that occur outside of the membership period.

Discussion around College athletes only paying event fees for a limited timeframe which would benefit a quarterly membership.

Board also questioned how much extra work this will mean for Volunteer Club Administrators.

Bryce to confirm with Athletics NZ that the proposed membership model forwarded in August will be the model moving forward from April 2023.
