### ANZ Balance is Better & Safe Sport for Children:

• BH invited Fiona Maisey from ANZ to present. ANZ have signed with Sport NZ as part of Balance is Better Philosophy

The philosophy is based on 9 principles, and Fiona presented on 3, namely

- 1. Quality Experiences, regardless of ability or motivations.
- 2. Bold and Courageous Leadership
- 3. Balance getting better with doing too much

ANZ are two years into signing up to this initiative and are currently working on delivery to grassroots centres/clubs.

Fiona also presented on ANZ Safe Sport for Children and spoke on the 4 steps to creating a safe sport environment for children.

- 1. Preventing those who have been identified as causing harm to children, from having contact with children in athletics.
- 2. Removing and/or minimizing any risks of, and opportunities for, harm to children.
- 3. Identifying and stopping inappropriate behaviours.
- 4. Providing support to children and their families should a child be harmed.
