AAI Section Spending Policy:

2023 NI Colgate Games:

- LOC met Thursday 6/7/23. List of Roles to be distributed to clubs in September.
- Athletics Auckland Inc. Motion to apply to The Lion Foundation for assistance with Accommodation for Athletics appointed Officials to officiate at the North Island Colgate Games hosted by Athletics Auckland at Go Media Mt Smart #2 Arena 5th/7th January 2024. The accommodation venue will be Waipuna Lodge, Mt Wellington. The total amount requested is up to \$24,000.00 (Twenty Four Thousand Dollars).

ANZ Updates:

- MM attended a staff farewell for current ANZ CEO Peter Pfitzinger during the week. Peter will be leaving the role after 4 ½ years. Both MM and BH have been invited to meet the incoming CEO Cam Mitchell who will commence in his new role on August 1st. New CEO to be invited to attend an AAI Board meeting at a convenient time.
- BH formally acknowledged the contribution Peter has made to our sport during his time as CEO.

Mt Smart:

- Mt Smart #2 Arena Refurbishment now concluded, with athletes back training at the venue. Signage to be put up around the track asking athletes to be respectful of and aware of their responsibilities when using the track.
- Tenants meeting postponed by Mt Smart until July.
- Gear Shed (using re-purposed funding from Foundation North) will be erected early August.
- Remaining Foundation North funds have been used to purchase gear, some of which will be available for Colgate Games in January 2024.

XCR June Minutes Tabled:

- XCR Trailer and Contents Insurance claims have been lodged and awaiting final
 payment figures. Claims Assessor advised Section could go ahead with immediate
 purchase of necessities needed to run an event. Pig tails, Reels and Generator have
 been purchased.
- Auckland Cross Country Championships held at Pukekohe on 24/6/23. Wet weather in the week leading up to the champs but the day was fine. Smaller numbers than expected competed on the day. Selections are currently under way for full teams to NZ Cross Country Championships in Taupo 29/7/23 for U18 and above age grades.
- BH raised query from Children's Minutes on Age Grade Teams for NZ Cross
 Country and Road Championships. DC advised the Centre selects athletes to contest
 the Teams evens at NZ Cross Country and Road championships. At present age
 grade teams are only recognised in the U18 and above grades. These are Athletic NZ
 Championships and any rule changes would need to go before the ANZ Rules
 committee.
- XCR committee are also discussing how to attract senior runners to national and local events. One suggestion would be to have a league series / league ladder where clubs / runners (maybe Top 5 runners per club) will score points. It will be important to provide clarity around this and exactly how it will work. It won't work if there is just general participation. Runners will have to attend all events in the series to score points. The GP series could be a good base to start the League Series off with.
